A motion made by Vice Mayor Neal, second by Councilman Sugarman to approve and authorize the Mayor to execute to Memorandum of Understanding with Loudon county for the Green Waste Project Study. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 7 Ayes

APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR PAVING BIDS FOR NORTH KENTUCKY STREET FROM I-40 TO HIGHWAY 70; PIN 119229.00; FEDERAL PROJECT #STP-M-9124(10); CONTRACT 13022

A motion made by Councilman White, second by Councilman Byrkit to approve and authorize the City Manager to advertise for bids on asphalt for the paving of N. Kentucky Street. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 7 Ayes

REAPPOINTMENT OF CHUCK HUTZLER TO AN 8-YEAR TERM ON THE PLANNING COMMISSION (NEW TERM BEGINNING NOVEMBER 1, 2013 AND ENDING OCTOBER 31, 2021)

A motion made by Councilman McClure, second by Vice Mayor Neal to reappoint Chuck Hutzler to serve another eight (8) year term on the Regional Planning Commission. Term will expire on October 31, 2021. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 7 Ayes
