The Regular meeting of the Kingston City Council was held on Tuesday, August 11, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Neal call the meeting to order with City Attorney McPherson giving the invocation and Councilman Childs leading the pledge. FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-613 OF THE MUNICIPAL ZONING ORDINANCE

A motion made by Councilman Sugarman, second by Councilman Byrkit to adopt on first reading Ordinance #15-8-11-2, to amend Section 11-613 of the Municipal Zoning Ordinance concerning the requirements for the construction of a building on multiple parcels. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 6 Ayes

FIRST READING OF A BUDGET CONTINUANCE ORDINANCE TO CONTINUE THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED IN THE FY 2014-2015 BUDGET AS THE APPROPRIATION FOR FY 2015-2016 UNTIL THE ADOPTION OF NEW ORDINANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH T.C.A. 6-56-210

A motion made by Councilman Byrkit, second by Councilman Sugarman to adopt on first reading Ordinance #15-8-11-1, to continue the FY2014-2015 budget appropriation until an ordinance for FY2015-2016 can be adopted. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 6 Ayes

ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF KINGSTON TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TML RISK MANAGEMENT POOL "SAFETY PARTNERS" LOSS CONTROL MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM

A motion made by Councilman Sugarman, second by Councilman Byrkit to adopt Resolution #15-8-11-2, authorizing participation in the TML Risk Management Pool "Safety Partners" Loss Control Matching Grant Program. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 6 Ayes

ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF KINGSTON TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TML RISK MANAGEMENT POOL "DRIVER SAFETY" LOSS CONTROL MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM

A motion made by Councilman White, second by Councilman Sugarman to authorize the participation in the TML Risk Management "Drivers Safety" Loss Control Matching Grant Program. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 6 Ayes

APPROVE A COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR

A motion made by Councilman Sugarman, second by Councilman White to approve a committee to bring recommendation to council in regards to the \$375,000.00 from TVA to rebuild the image of Kingston following the ash spill. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 6 Ayes

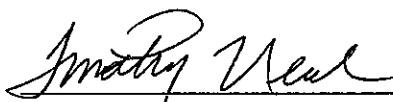

A motion made by Councilman Sugarman, second by Councilman Childs to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed with a unanimous voice vote.

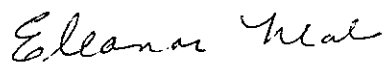
Mayor Neal adjourned the meeting.
