1. SECOND READING OF AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY CODE TITLE 13, BY ADDING REGULATIONS FOR REMOVAL OF VEGETATION AND DEBRIS FROM OVERGROWN AND DIRTY LOTS

A motion made by Councilman Sugarman, second by Councilman Childs to adopt on second reading Ordinance #15-9-8-2, AMENDING Title 13 of the City Code concerning the removal and debris from overgrown and dirty lots. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 7 Ayes

1. APPROVE CONSTRUCTION OF A PAVILION AT THE GRAVEL PIT WITH TVA ENHANCEMENT FUNDING (CAPPED AT \$56,000)

A motion made by Councilman Sugarman, second by Councilman White to use up to \$56,000 of the TVA Enhancement Funds on the construction of a pavilion at the gravel pit. The motion passed with the following roll call vote taken: Vice Mayor Brown, Nay; Councilman Byrkit, Aye; Councilman Childs, Aye; Councilwoman Humphreys, Aye; Councilman Sugarman, Aye; Councilman White, Aye; Mayor Neal, Aye. 6 Ayes 1 Nay

2. APPROVE THE HOME PROGRAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AND RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF KINGSTON

A motion made by Vice Mayor Brown, second by Councilman Sugarman to adopt Resolution #15-10-13, approving the Housing Rehabilitation Policies and Procedures. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 7 Ayes


A motion made by Councilman White, second by Councilman Sugarman to adjourn the meeting passed with a unanimous voice vote.
