City of Kingston Signs Contract With Energy Source Partners for Phase II Solar Energy

KINGSTON, Tenn. – The City of Kingston and Energy Source Partners LLC signed a contract today which begins the process for the second phase of solar energy production in Kingston. In this agreement Energy Source Partners agrees to lease city property located on James Ferry Road in Kingston on property formerly used by the Kingston Water Department. They plan to design, build, finance, operate and maintain an electricity grid-connected photovoltaic solar power system with a generating capacity rated at approximately 200 kWdc. TVA will purchase at a premium all of the green energy output from this Generating Facility under their Renewable Standard Offer and SSI Agreements, as well as other federal, state, and local green power incentive programs.
