Mayor Troy Beets is pleased to announce that the City of Kingston has received the Notice to Proceed on the paving of North Kentucky Street. In a letter from the Tennessee Department of Transportation, the City was notified that they may immediately begin advertising for bids, which must be done for a minimum of 21 days.

“After pursuing State Transportation Project (STP) funding for over a year, I am very excited to say that we’ll soon begin resurfacing North Kentucky Street from the intersection of Highways 58 and 70 downtown to the Interstate. This will be a major improvement to a very busy road in the heart of our city and will be accomplished at no expense to the local taxpayers” said Beets. “I work tirelessly to maintain good working relationships with officials in Nashville and Washington, and this is a great example of how those relationships benefit the residents of Kingston”.

The City plans to open bids in mid to late November and hopes to begin work immediately thereafter.
